TERMS & CONDITIONS

Security Deposits: In accordance with the Tonopah Public Utilities regulations, each applicant must pay a deposit as set by resolution and adopted by the Town Board. Commercial account deposits are held until the account is closed, then applied to the final bill. Any remaining balance will be refunded to the customer at the address on file.

Payment of Bills: Billings are due upon receipt and are considered past due if payment is not received by the due date. Bills not paid on or before the due date shall be considered delinquent and assessed a 10% penalty of the outstanding balance that will be added to the customer's bill. Accounts sixty (60) days or more past due are subject to service disconnection and an additional \$25.00 Disconnect fee, unless acceptable payment arrangements are made with this office prior to the "Shut-Off" date.

After Hours Non-Emergency Call-Out Customer requests for non-emergency services between the hours of 3:00 pm and 7:00 am Monday through Friday or anytime on Saturday, Sunday or State and Federal Holidays shall be charged a "Call-Out Fee" as set by resolution and adopted by the Town Board.

Returned Payments A fee of \$42.00 shall be charged for all payments returned by the customers financial institution as unpaid. When a customer has more than two returned payments in a twelve (12) month period, the Utility requires all payments from that point must be made in CERTIFIED FUNDS (cash, money order, bank check). The customer will remain on Certified Funds only status until satisfactory credit is reestablished with the Utility.

The Utility shall not be responsible for damage to property caused by faucets, valves and other equipment that are open when the water is turned on at the meter, either originally or when turned on after a temporary shut off.

Furthermore, I agree to comply with the Town of Tonopah - Tonopah Public Utilities (TPU) Water, Sewer, and Reclaimed Water Regulations and any other applicable local state and federal laws.
