TERMS & CONDITIONS

Deposit: In accordance with Town of Tonopah - Tonopah Public Utilities Water, Sewer, and Reclaimed Water Regulations, Article I, Section Thirteen; each applicant shall pay a deposit and deposit amounts shall be set forth by the Utility ranging from \$75.00 to \$350.00 per meter. No interest will be paid on security deposits.

Payment of bills: Pursuant TPU Regulations Section Fourteen: Billings and Payments: Billings which are not paid on or before the due date shall be considered delinquent. Delinquent bills shall be subject to a penalty of 10% of the amount due and added to the customer's bill. Accounts 60 days or more past due are subject to termination unless acceptable payment arrangements are made with this office prior to termination. Failure to comply with a payment arrangement may result in termination of service. Accounts that have water and sewer service suspended or terminated shall be charged an additional \$25.00 disconnect fee.

Returned check fee: A fee of \$42.00 shall be charged for all returned checks.

Call-out fees: Customer requests for non-emergency service between the hours of 3:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. Monday through Friday or anytime on Saturday, Sunday or observed holidays will be charged a \$50.00 call out fee.

The Utility shall not be responsible for damage to property caused by faucets, valves and other equipment that are open when the water is turned on at the meter, either originally or when turned on after a temporary shut off.

Pursuant to the Town of Tonopah – Tonopah Public Utilities Water, Sewer and Reclaimed Water Regulations, Article 1, §6.1.3, five years after the Utility determines that a service is abandoned, deserted, inactive or removed, the ERU(s) associated with such service will be considered no longer valid and will revert to the Utility.
